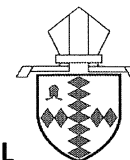

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FIRE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND INSPECTIONS:

Fire systems:

- Bi-annual inspection of fire detection and alarm systems – tested and certified by RJ Fire. Last inspection and service on 15/08/2023.
- Annual emergency lighting discharge test and certification by RJ Fire. Last inspection and service on 15/08/2023.
- Annual inspection and certification of fire-fighting equipment by RJ Fire. Last inspection on 15/08/2023.
- Fire drills every term arranged by school. Recorded in Fire Book.
- Weekly testing of fire bells by Fred Kolndreu, recorded.
- Emergency lights tested monthly by Fred Kolndreu and recorded.
- Fire evacuation procedures reviewed January 2023.
- School kept clear of combustable materials.
- Corridors kept clear of obstacles to evacuation.
- Premises kept secured with doors and windows shut when not in use.
- Fire Exits displayed.

Electricals:

- Portable Appliance Testing (PAT) by Fred Kolndreu, trained in PAT testing.
- Fixed Electricals tested every 5 years (last test December 2019). Buy back to Surrey Services for Schools for 5-year check, will be due 2024.

Site security:

- All visitors via main School Entrance. Visitors only allowed access through intercom system. Visitors ID checked by school staff. All visitors sign in and issued with visitors badge. All visitors sign themselves out
- Intruder alarm in place. Annual inspection by Admiral Security. Latest service 01/08/2023.
- All moveable objects locked.
- No smoking premises with clear signage to this effect at school entrance. All contractors and visitors aware.

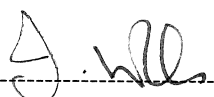

Note: 9th May 2013 Philippa Assender (previous Bursar) telephoned Kenneth Holdsworth, Babcock 4S (Now Strictly Education 4S) Health and Safety Advisor, for advice on whether the bungalow should be included in the school's fire risk assessment. Mr Holdsworth advised that as the bungalow is a separate building and not attached to the school building there is no need to include it in the school fire risk assessment. The bungalow is the personal space for the resident site manager and his family; if, for example, gas bottles were stored then this would have to be re-considered. No need for PAT testing in the bungalow.
